## 1. TITLE

Approval to Vary Housing Independence Service's Rough Sleeper Service Contract to include Grant Funding from the MHCLG, for the Rough Sleeper Initiative

## 2. DECISION TAKEN

Variation to the Rough Sleeper Outreach Service Contract to increase the contract value by $£ 25,000$ as outlined in the report.

## 3. Reasons For Decision

The grant from the MHCLG will provide a temporary outreach worker for one year to assist in testing approaches to tackle rough sleeping in Sheffield. It will enable the Council and its partners to target the most vulnerable people, sleeping rough or at risk of street homelessness.

Approval to vary the Housing Independence Service's Rough Sleeper Service Contract will enable the grant payment for the worker to be made to Framework on a monthly basis to enable the post holder to assist with the Council's duties.

## 4. Alternatives Considered And Rejected

No other alternative options were considered as Housing Independence Service already had a contract in place with Framework Housing Association to deliver an outreach service to rough sleepers. The post will enable the extension of that service and therefore it would be appropriate to vary the contract to extend the funding for the service to meet the requirements of the successful bid.
