#### ADVICE TO MEMBERS ON DECLARING INTERESTS AT MEETINGS

If you are present at a meeting of the Council, of its executive or any committee of the executive, or of any committee, sub-committee, joint committee, or joint sub-committee of the authority, and you have a **Disclosable Pecuniary Interest** (DPI) relating to any business that will be considered at the meeting, you must not:

- participate in any discussion of the business at the meeting, or if you become aware of your Disclosable Pecuniary Interest during the meeting, participate further in any discussion of the business, or
- participate in any vote or further vote taken on the matter at the meeting.

These prohibitions apply to any form of participation, including speaking as a member of the public.

#### You **must**:

- leave the room (in accordance with the Members' Code of Conduct)
- make a verbal declaration of the existence and nature of any DPI at any
  meeting at which you are present at which an item of business which affects or
  relates to the subject matter of that interest is under consideration, at or before
  the consideration of the item of business or as soon as the interest becomes
  apparent.
- declare it to the meeting and notify the Council's Monitoring Officer within 28 days, if the DPI is not already registered.

If you have any of the following pecuniary interests, they are your **disclosable pecuniary interests** under the new national rules. You have a pecuniary interest if you, or your spouse or civil partner, have a pecuniary interest.

- Any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit or gain, which you, or your spouse or civil partner undertakes.
- Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from your council or authority) made or provided within the relevant period\* in respect of any expenses incurred by you in carrying out duties as a member, or towards your election expenses. This includes any payment or financial benefit from a trade union within the meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.

\*The relevant period is the 12 months ending on the day when you tell the Monitoring Officer about your disclosable pecuniary interests.

- Any contract which is made between you, or your spouse or your civil partner (or a body in which you, or your spouse or your civil partner, has a beneficial interest) and your council or authority –
  - under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and
  - which has not been fully discharged.

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- Any beneficial interest in land which you, or your spouse or your civil partner, have and which is within the area of your council or authority.
- Any licence (alone or jointly with others) which you, or your spouse or your civil
  partner, holds to occupy land in the area of your council or authority for a month
  or longer.
- Any tenancy where (to your knowledge)
  - the landlord is your council or authority; and
  - the tenant is a body in which you, or your spouse or your civil partner, has a beneficial interest.
- Any beneficial interest which you, or your spouse or your civil partner has in securities of a body where -
  - (a) that body (to your knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of your council or authority; and
  - (b) either -
    - the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or
    - if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which you, or your spouse or your civil partner, has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.

If you attend a meeting at which any item of business is to be considered and you are aware that you have a **personal interest** in the matter which does not amount to a DPI, you must make verbal declaration of the existence and nature of that interest at or before the consideration of the item of business or as soon as the interest becomes apparent. You should leave the room if your continued presence is incompatible with the 7 Principles of Public Life (selflessness; integrity; objectivity; accountability; openness; honesty; and leadership).

You have a personal interest where -

- a decision in relation to that business might reasonably be regarded as affecting
  the well-being or financial standing (including interests in land and easements
  over land) of you or a member of your family or a person or an organisation with
  whom you have a close association to a greater extent than it would affect the
  majority of the Council Tax payers, ratepayers or inhabitants of the ward or
  electoral area for which you have been elected or otherwise of the Authority's
  administrative area, or
- it relates to or is likely to affect any of the interests that are defined as DPIs but are in respect of a member of your family (other than a partner) or a person with whom you have a close association.

Guidance on declarations of interest, incorporating regulations published by the Government in relation to Disclosable Pecuniary Interests, has been circulated to you previously.

You should identify any potential interest you may have relating to business to be considered at the meeting. This will help you and anyone that you ask for advice to fully consider all the circumstances before deciding what action you should take.

In certain circumstances the Council may grant a **dispensation** to permit a Member to take part in the business of the Authority even if the member has a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest relating to that business.

To obtain a dispensation, you must write to the Monitoring Officer at least 48 hours before the meeting in question, explaining why a dispensation is sought and desirable, and specifying the period of time for which it is sought. The Monitoring Officer may consult with the Independent Person or the Council's Audit and Standards Committee in relation to a request for dispensation.



## REPORT OF THE CHIEF LICENSING OFFICER Ref No 93/17 (HEAD OF LICENSING) TO THE LICENSING SUB COMMITTEE LICENSING ACT 2003

#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider an application for the grant of a premises licence made under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.

#### 2.0 THE APPLICATION

- 2.1 The applicant is The Branded Burger Company Limited.
- 2.2 The application, which was received on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2017, is attached to this report labelled Appendix 'A'.

#### 3.0 REASONS FOR REFERRAL

3.1 Representations concerning the application have been received from the following and are attached at Appendix B:-

#### • No 7 - Public

- 3.2 Responsible Authorities, namely South Yorkshire Police and the Health & Safety Authority have agreed conditions with the applicant during the consultation period. The objectors to the application have been made aware of these conditions either by e-mail or by post. A copy of these conditions are attached at appendix 'C'.
- 3.3 The applicant and objectors have been invited to attend the hearing. Copies of the front page of the notices are attached to this report labelled Appendix 'D'

#### 4.0 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 4.1 The consultation period for this application was restarted on the 13th June 2017 due to failure to advertise the application in accordance with the Licensing Act Regulations Statutory Instrument 2005 No 42.
- 4.2 On the 28th June 2017 the applicant by e-mail, removed the proposed licensable activities of live music and recorded music from the application and also amended the times for the sale by retail of alcohol for consumption on the premises; requested hours from 12:00 noon until 11:45pm. This was in order to reflect the correct licensable activities advertised in the Sheffield Star newspaper provided by the applicant. The public notice was therefore amended on the 28th June 2017 and subsequently displayed at the premises. A visit to the premises was made by Licensing Enforcement Officers on the evening of the 28th June 2017 and details of the notice were found to be correct. The Pending Licensing Application list, published on the Sheffield City Council Licensing web page, was updated accordingly on the 29th June 2017 to reflect the amended application.

- 4.3 The Licensing Authority assessed these changes to the application and took the decision that as the proposed licensable activities and times had been reduced, the consultation period would not be re-started or re-advertised in the newspaper as this would not have a detrimental effect on any interested party. The Licensing Authority had received no objections to the application from any residents or interested parties at this stage.
- 4.4 Officers have attempted to mediate in this matter, but unfortunately this has been unsuccessful and therefore must be heard by the Licensing Sub-Committee. Further details can be provided at the hearing upon request.

#### 5.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no specific financial implications arising from this application. However, additional costs may be incurred should the matter go to appeal. In such an eventuality it may not be possible to recover all these costs. The impact of these additional costs (if any) will be kept under review and may be subject of a further report during the year.

#### 6.0 THE LEGAL POSITION

- 6.1 The Licensing Act 2003 at section 4 (1) requires the Licensing Authority to carry out its functions with a view to promoting the Licensing Objectives which section 4(2) sets out as:
  - a) the prevention of crime and disorder,
  - b) public safety,
  - c) the prevention of public nuisance,
  - d) the protection of children from harm.
- 6.2 Section 4(3) of the Licensing Act also requires the Licensing Authority to have regard to the published statement of Licensing Policy and any guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182.

#### 7.0 HEARINGS REGULATIONS

- 7.1 Regulations governing hearings under the Licensing Act 2003 have been made by the Secretary of State.
- 7.2 The Licensing Authority has provided all parties with the information required in the Regulations to the 2003 Act as set out at Appendix 'D'.
- 7.3 Attached at Appendix 'D' is the following:
  - a) a copy of the Notice of Hearing:
  - b) the rights of a party provided in Regulations 15 and 16;
  - c) the consequences if a party does not attend or is not represented at the hearing
  - d) the procedure to be followed at the hearing.

#### 8.0 APPEALS

8.1 The Licensing Act 2003 section 181 and Schedule 5 makes provision for appeals to be made by the applicant and those making representations against decisions of the Licensing Authority to the Magistrates' Court.

#### 9.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

9.1 That Members carefully consider the representations made and take such steps as the Sub Committee consider appropriate for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.

#### 10.0 OPTIONS OPEN TO THE COMMITTEE

- 10.1 To grant the premises licence in the terms requested.
- 10.2 To grant the premises licence with conditions.
- 10.3 To reject the whole or part of the application.



As nearby residents we oppose the hours for the sale of refreshments including alcohol. Walton Road is mostly three storey houses on a narrow road, with a slight curve in the middle. We find that any noise on Ecclesall Road or the lower part of this road is channelled and amplified. We are aware of traffic noise in Ecclesall Road, and its diminution later in the evening.

We would be aware of normal conversational exchanges taking place on the proposed outdoor area of the restaurant. There will also be noise created as customers leave and return to parked cars in Walton and surrounding roads. Nearby restaurants in Ecclesall Road have Licensing restrictions limiting the use of their outdoor areas to 21.00. On occasions when this has been breached residents in side roads have been well aware of the noise, leading to action by the Licensing Service.

We have very good reasons to believe that the proposed hours will cause unacceptable disturbance to us and other local residents, a clear case of potential public nuisance. We therefore request that operating hours for the outdoor area be limited to 21.00, in line with other premises in the area.

### OBJECTION TO AN APPLICATION FOR AN ALCOHOL LICENCE AT 474 ECCLESALL ROAD

I believe the application should be refused on the grounds of public nuisance. The premises are on the corner of a residential street and this area is already under tremendous pressure from the large number of licenced premises in the vicinity. Within 600 metres in either direction I have counted 23 premises in operation with licences to sell alcohol on their premises. In addition there are 5 further such premises on Sharrow Vale Road. On top of that there are a number of empty premises on Ecclesall Road which have already been granted alcohol licences and could come back into operation at any time.

As a result of the number of licenced premises in the area, which collectively have a capacity for well over 1,500 people, Ecclesall Road is becoming saturated with revellers, resulting in noise, nuisance, parking problems and congestion (many taxis double-parked to pick up/put down their fares). The situation is already unacceptable and there is no justification for licencing yet another premises when there are already licenced premises in the area available for occupation.

The premises at 474 Ecclesall Road are especially unsuited for a licence as it is on the corner of a residential street and the inevitable noise from music and people congregating on the street and inside the building will cause a public nuisance. I also witness on a daily basis the nuisance caused by daily food and drink deliveries – lorries blocking side streets and sometimes holding up traffic in both directions on Ecclesall Road. 474 Ecclesall road has no convenient places for the unloading of deliveries, which are frequent where fresh food and drink is on offer. There are double yellow lines immediately outside the premises and mixed resident/public parking bays along the side.

I am writing to register my objection to the application for a premises license shown above. The basis for this opposition is that granting a license for these premises will not promote the licensing objectives, particularly the prevention of crime, disorder and antisocial behaviour.

Granting a license would provide a further source of alcohol and takeaway food within an area already so heavily populated with licensed premises that crime, disorder and public nuisance have already reached problem levels for the local community.

Residents in this area already suffer noise nuisance and antisocial behaviour at all hours of the day and night. We already suffer litter from takeaways strewn in our gardens and there is no need to compound this further.

The noise nuisance from these premises will be made unacceptable if food and alcohol is served outside until 11.45 every night as the nature of the layout of roads means all noise carries up the road since the width and the terraced housing means it acts like a funnel. Thus noise at the bottom of the street can be heard at the top. This is unacceptable, especially as the customers of the premises are not likely to leave until well after midnight and the effects of alcohol are likely to mean that there will be much louder noise from customers as well as the likelihood of taxis being ordered or waiting for clients. These always park with their engines running further adding to the noise levels. Since the area is part of a resident parking scheme taxis are more likely to be used. In view of the above, I would urge the Licensing Authority to refuse the application.



I am writing in regard to the Licence application from The Branded Burger Co, 474 Ecclesall Road, Sheffield, S11 8PX. I live at Ecclesall Road which is directly over Walton Road from these premises. I am frankly horrified at the prospect that people will be able to sit drinking directly outside my living accommodation until virtually midnight each night. I run a physiotherapy clinic from the down stairs of the building and find the application to be wholly unsuitable.

Some other bars and pubs close at 11pm in the local area and clearly such a fast food outlet will act as a magnet for individuals who are already under the influence and will therefore not be very considerate of those of us who wake each morning and start treating patients at 8.00am. I am also concerned for the safety of our patients who clearly are in pain, disabled or both and may be leaving the clinic following attending for their physiotherapy treatment session as late as 9pm. Obviously staff would also be leaving the premises sometime after this also. I am also concerned for my own personal safety. I would be extremely uneasy about returning home close to midnight and being watched getting out of my car entering the building then walking upstairs and turning the lights on. In this day and age you just don't know what sort of person is watching and providing a viewing platform with food and drink laid on seems like an intolerable burden to bear.

It is impossible to imagine how this might benefit the area. There is already a closed burger restaurant formally Yankees, 418 Ecclesall Road. This has a terrace outside, however they were not allowed to have people sit outside after 9pm and the restaurant closed at 11 in line with the other restaurants in the area. There are already three restaurants directly opposite my house on Ecclesall Road. These premises are not allowed to serve people outside after 9pm and they close at around 11pm each night also. I have not found that there is a particular noise nuisance related to these premises at the current time, and I did not object to their licensing applications.

This application is in my opinion not really an application for a burger restaurant at all, it is in reality an application for a bar and they are using the Burger Restaurant as a way to circumvent the appropriate licencing regulations. The same thing was done when an Italian restaurant at 543 Ecclesall Road closed. It was replaced with a Mexican themed bar/restaurant where the emphasis was clearly on the bar and the food was merely a thin veneer in order to satisfy the licencing regulations. This premise is now the Monk Bar which is as the name implies is now just a bar and no longer a restaurant.

I trust that you are able to understand my deep feelings of worry about this proposal. I live and work in the same building and have no possibility to move away if the planning application is granted and in so doing the level of noise, antisocial behaviour and crime in the area directly around me increase while the level of safety and security for my patients, staff and myself decrease.

We wish to object to the above application with reference to the licensing objective of prevention of public nuisance, which is not addressed in the application. Our objection is specifically to the proposed hours of operation and use of the upper floor.

The application does not take account of the location of the premises in a residential area or the layout and geography of the surroundings. The premises is on the corner of Ecclesall Road and Walton Road, in a terrace of shops with flats above and terraced housing beyond that and with a small back yard facing a gable wall and the rear gardens of houses on Khartoum Road.

Walton Road is a narrow road with high houses slopng upwards from Ecclesall Road. Noise is funnelled up the road and amplified: this is especially noticeable when traffic and daytime ambient noise die down in the evening. Groups of customers using the outdoor patio area at the street corner late in the evening will cause significant noise nuisance to the residents of Walton Road and the adjacent flats and houses on Ecclesall Road. Similarly, groups of customers leaving the premises late at night will be clearly audible.

The premises is subject to planning conditions limiting use of the external forecourt to no later than 9.00 pm, and requiring customers to leave the premises by 10.30 pm Sunday to Thursday and 11.00 pm Friday and Saturday. Other licensed premises in the neighbourhood have similar licensing restrictions which we feel work well and are properly monitored. We would not object to a condition of the licence restricting the hours of use to those stated in the planning conditions.

There is also a planning condition restricting use of the upper floor, stating that it is not to be used for any seating/eating area at any time. The gradient of Walton Road means that Khartoum Road is on a higher level than the buildings on Ecclesall Road and the area between the two is bounded by high brick walls (including

the gable wall of 6 Walton Road). These also serve to amplify noise. We ask that if use of the upper floor for dining is approved (subject to planning permission being granted) then it should be subject to a condition restricting noise outbreak.

The location is on the corner of Walton Rd which is on a hill with terraced brick housing on each side of the road. This road layout means noise from Ecclesall Rd and any point on Walton Rd funnels up the hill and is amplified. The application fails to take into account the noise nuisance it will cause given the residential nature of the location. All other licensed premises in the area have restrictions where outside areas can not be used after 9pm and any decision which would allow this location to be used outdoors any later would be completely inappropriate.

The area immediately behind and above these premises is filled with residential properties whose back yards/ windows face the kitchen area which is proposed on the first floor of the location. Any odours or noise from the first floor will disproportionately affect these properties and other residences on Walton Rd. Windows should be kept closed and ventilation directed towards Ecclesall Rd.

- 4. The Solicitor to the Committee will outline the procedure to be followed at the hearing.
- 5. Hearing Procedure:-
  - (a) The Licensing Officer will introduce the report.
  - (b) Questions concerning the report can be asked both by Members and the applicant.
  - (c) The Licensing Officer will introduce in turn representatives for the Responsible Authority and Interested Parties who will be asked to detail their relevant representations.
  - (d) Members may ask questions of those parties
  - (e) With the leave of the Chair the applicant or his representative may cross examine the representatives of the Responsible Authorities and Interested Parties.
  - (f) The applicant/licensee (or his/her nominated representative) will then be asked to:-
    - (i) detail the application;
    - (ii) provide clarification on the application and respond to the representations made.
  - (g) The applicant/licensee (or his/her nominated representative) may then be asked questions by members and with the leave of the Chair from the other parties present.
  - (h) The applicant will then be given the opportunity to sum up the application.
  - (i) The Licensing Officer will then detail the options.
  - (j) There will then be a private session for members to take legal advice and consider the application.
- 6. The decision of the Licensing Committee will be given in accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 and regulations made there under.
- NB: 1) At any time in the Licensing Process Members of the Committee may request legal advice from the Solicitor to the Committee. This advice may be given in open session or in private.
  - The Committee Hearing will be held in public unless and in accordance with the Regulations the Committee determine that the public should be excluded.

4.1 Officers have attempted to mediate in this matter, but unfortunately this has been unsuccessful and therefore must be heard by the Licensing Sub-Committee. Further details can be provided at the hearing upon request.

#### 5.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

In such an eventuality it may not be possible to recover all these costs. The impact of these additional costs (if any) will be kept under review and may be subject of a further report during the year.

- 6.2 Section 4(3) of the Licensing Act also requires the Licensing Authority to have regard to the published statement of Licensing Policy and any guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182.

#### 7.0 HEARINGS REGULATIONS

- 7.1 Regulations governing hearings under the Licensing Act 2003 have been made by the Secretary of State.
- 7.2 The Licensing Authority has provided all parties with the information required in the Regulations to the 2003 Act as set out at Appendix 'D'.
- 7.3 Attached at Appendix 'D' is the following:
  - a) a copy of the Notice of Hearing;
  - b) the rights of a party provided in Regulations 15 and 16;
  - c) the consequences if a party does not attend or is not represented at the hearing
  - d) the procedure to be followed at the hearing.

#### 8.0 APPEALS

8.1 The Licensing Act 2003 section 181 and Schedule 5 makes provision for appeals to be made by the applicant and those making representations against decisions of the Licensing Authority to the Magistrates' Court.

#### 9.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

9.1 That Members carefully consider the representations made and take such steps as the Sub Committee consider appropriate for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.

#### 10.0 OPTIONS OPEN TO THE COMMITTEE

- 10.1 To grant the premises licence in the terms requested.
- 10.2 To grant the premises licence with conditions.
- 10.3 To reject the whole or part of the application.



I am emailing to confirm receipt of your representation received relating to the application made by Domino's Pizza for a premises licence to be granted under the Licensing Act 2003.

The last date for comments on the application is 21st July, I am emailing to inform you to advise that the application will be referred to the Licensing Sub-Committee for a decision to be made if the representations cannot be resolved between the applicant and the objectors. I am therefore writing to advise you that the applicant has offered a number of conditions within their operating procedure to address some of the core objectives under the Licensing Act 2003 and have attached a copy of the operating schedule for you to look at.

I am also emailing to advise that the applicant has agreed with South Yorkshire Police that a 30 day recording CCTV system to the specification of South Yorkshire Police will be fitted and maintained in the premises at all times that the premises are open to the public.

Whilst I appreciate your representation relates to current issues in the area relating to noise nuisance and littering, I must point out that these exiting issues do not relate to a new premises and that your representation must be based on evidence and you will be invited to attend a hearing to put forward any evidence to support your representation.

I will be requesting details from the applicant on what measures they propose to put in place to ensure that any litter deriving from their premises is collected from neighbouring properties and hope that they can offer a condition suitable that would address this point that you have made.

We write to oppose the grant of a Take away licence for Late night refreshment from 2300 – 0500. Whilst such operating hours may be acceptable for city centre locations (as part of the "24hour city") this location is not suitable. From this address outward in Ecclesall Road there are residential streets on both sides. The primary market for those seeking take away pizzas during these hours will be people who have been enjoying largely non-food establishments, including bars, elsewhere. Many will then walk along Ecclesall Road, creating noise to the disturbance of residents.

It is not possible for the management of Domino's to inhibit the noise thus created, nor the inevitable litter of empty/ part finished pizza boxes.

We strongly believe that this public nuisance should be avoided, and that the latest closing time, in line with other hot food take aways in this residential area, should be 2330.

Thanks for the further information.

The litter picking is a welcome initiative, however it doesn't address the noise nuisance issues caused by customers arriving and leaving late at night.

I am happy for the application to be approved but with an earlier closing time of 11.30pm. Any later would be unfair on other businesses in the area who close earlier (in line with residents wishes). The addition of Dominos as a possible (unsociably early morning) stop on the way home from a night out would mean people walking home via dominos or stopping their taxis at dominos. Both add street noise and traffic to a residential area and cause sleepless nights for those living nearby.

It's nice that Dominos would train their staff to call the police and will add a CCTV system to South Yorkshire Police standards. That they are doing so as a matter of course suggests they expect problems to occur.

In reality there is no need to create a situation to increase the possibility of calling the police in the middle of the night in a residential area. There is no social benefit to opening most of the night and a probability of social harm. Any harm can be avoided by the business closing at 11.30pm.

## Right of attendance, assistance and representation

15. Subject to regulations 14(2) and 25, a party may attend the hearing and may be assisted or represented by any person whether or not that person is legally qualified.

## Representations and supporting information

16. At the hearing a party shall be entitled to -

- (a) in response to a point upon which the authority has given notice to a party that it will want clarification under regulation 7(1)(d), give further information in support of their application, representations or notice (as applicable),
- (b) if given permission by the authority, question any other party; and
- (c) address the authority

## Failure of parties to attend the hearing

- 20. (1) If a party has informed the authority that he does not intend to attend or be represented at a hearing, the hearing may proceed in his absence.
  - (2) If a party who has not so indicated fails to attend or be represented at a hearing the authority may:—
    - (a) where it considers it to be necessary in the public interest, adjourn the hearing to a specified date, or
    - (b) hold the hearing in the party's absence.
  - (3) Where the authority holds the hearing in the absence of a party, the authority shall consider at the hearing the application, representations or notice made by that party.

  - (a) The Licensing Officer will introduce the report.
  - (b) Questions concerning the report can be asked both by Members and the applicant.
  - (c) The Licensing Officer will introduce in turn representatives for the Responsible Authority and Interested Parties who will be asked to detail their relevant representations.
  - (d) Members may ask questions of those parties
  - (e) With the leave of the Chair the applicant or his representative may cross examine the representatives of the Responsible Authorities and Interested Parties.
  - (f) The applicant/licensee (or his/her nominated representative) will then be asked to:-
    - (i) detail the application;
    - (ii) provide clarification on the application and respond to the representations made
  - (g) The applicant/licensee (or his/her nominated representative) may then be asked questions by members and with the leave of the Chair from the other parties present.
  - (h) The applicant will then be given the opportunity to sum up the application.
  - (i) The Licensing Officer will then detail the options.
  - (j) There will then be a private session for members to take legal advice and consider the application.
- 6. The decision of the Licensing Committee will be given in accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 and regulations made there under.
- NB: 1) At any time in the Licensing Process Members of the Committee may request legal advice from the Solicitor to the Committee. This advice may be given in open session or in private.
  - 2) The Committee Hearing will be held in public unless and in accordance with the Regulations the Committee determine that the public should be excluded.
