

Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice under Regulation 10: Key Decision where less than 28 days' public notice has been given

Pursuant to Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 ('the Regulations'), **I hereby give Notice** that:-

The **Leader** intends to make a Key Decision on behalf of the Sheffield City Council **not before 9th August 2017**

The Key Decision will be about Month 3 Capital approvals providing details of the additions and variations to the Capital Programme.

It has not been possible to give 28 clear days' notice of the intention to make the Key Decision, as required by Regulation 9 (2) of the Regulations.

The reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable in this matter are as follows:-

These Capital Approval decisions were originally due to be taken by Cabinet on 9th August 2017 as part of an item on Revenue Budget and Capital Programme Monitoring 2017/18 Month 3. Notice of the Cabinet item had been published within the Forward Plan since 23rd March 2017. On 13th July, following the cancellation of the August Cabinet meeting, the item had been rescheduled for the Cabinet meeting on 20th September. However, there remains a need to obtain the Capital approvals prior to that new date in order to obtain authorisation to allow capital projects to meet key deadlines. Therefore, this element of the original decision should have remained in the Forward Plan to be taken as a Leader's decision. Due to an oversight, this had not happened, resulting in the need to issue this Regulation 10 Notice.
