An excluded matter is defined as a local crime and disorder matter within the meaning of section 19 of the Police and Justice Act 2006. A matter which consists of an allegation of systemic failure of an authority to discharge a function for which the authority is responsible may be referred to an Overview and Scrutiny and Policy Development Committee, notwithstanding the fact that the allegation specifies matters which would otherwise be excluded.
