The Covid-19 pandemic has had a significant impact on the facilities ability to generate income and without additional funding from SCC it will not be possible for SCT or PL to open any leisure provision in the city.
- II. SCT and PL therefore require urgent funding, by way of loan or grant, to meet additional costs and lost revenue caused by the Covid 19 pandemic.
