The Story So Far

We recently asked Hillsborough residents and businesses if they would like to see a permit parking scheme on the local streets. We are grateful to everyone who took the time to give us their feedback.

Your feedback has helped us decide which roads would be included in the scheme and how to balance the parking needs of different drivers during the day. We have now put together detailed proposals which are shown in this leaflet.

How did we choose the areas?

We have only chosen those streets where your feedback showed majority support for a scheme and where we know from our survey work that parking would benefit from something being done. We have not included the streets where there was little support or where there are just too many residents' cars for the available space.

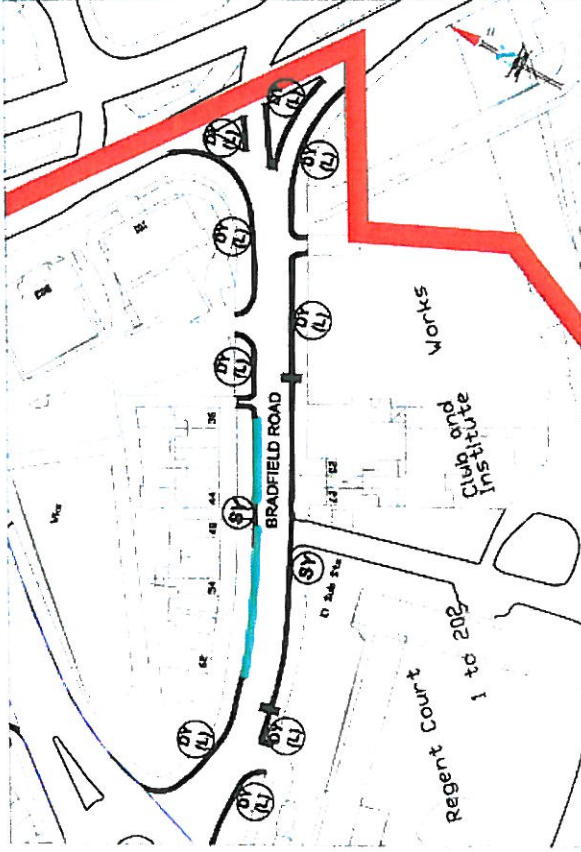
KEY 1 (B) RUDYARD RD / BRADFIELD RD AREA

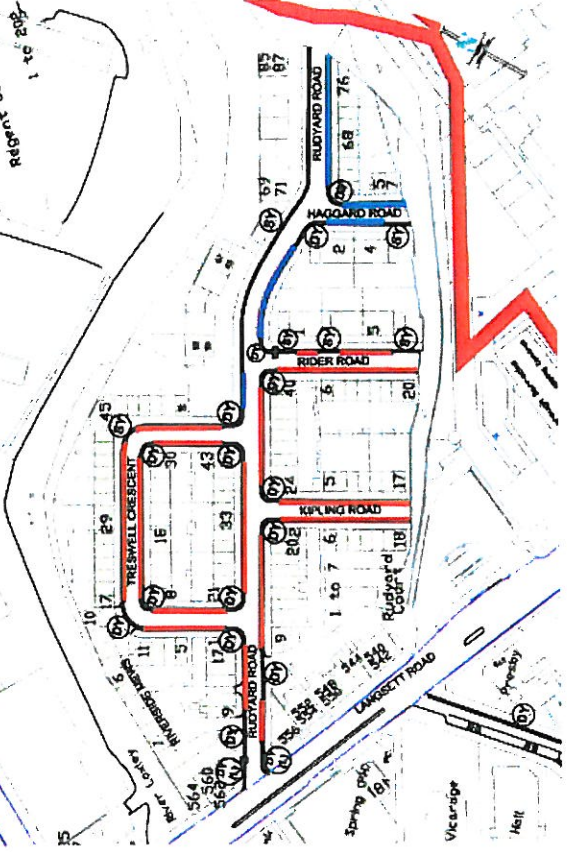

What happens next?

Your comments will help us put together the final plans for your area. We will then ask for your feedback on the Traffic Regulation Order (TRO). A TRO makes the new restrictions legally enforceable. Any objections to the TRO will be looked at by Councillors who will then decide either to introduce the order, with or without changes, or not at all.



How the scheme works

- You will need to display a valid permit to park in Permit Holder or Shared Use parking bays during the hours of operation
- Permit Holders can park for any length of time in these bays
- You can buy Permits from the Council
- Limited Waiting (free), Pay and Display (20p an hour) and any unrestricted roads are available to non-permit holders
- Shared Use Bays allow permit holders and non-permit holders to park in the same bay. For non-permit holders, these bays will have some restrictions such as Limited Waiting or Pay and Display
- Permits are specific to this scheme but not to individual streets
- The scheme cannot reserve specific spaces for individuals and does not guarantee there always being an available space
- Residents and Businesses will be able to have up to two permits per property, with the possibility of more if there is enough space, at the second permit price

Resident property	£10	£30
Business property	£20	£60

Other Permit type	Price
Visitor Permits	£2.50 for a book of 25 daily permits
Trade Permits (contractors and landlords)	£25 for a book of 25 daily permits
Special (carers and medical agencies making house calls)	£5 per year

Disabled Blue Badge Holders will need a permit to park in a Permit Holder Only bay. You can park without time limit in Shared Use and Limited Waiting Bays and the normal rules apply elsewhere.

Yellow lines and parking bays are enforced by the Council's Civil Enforcement Officers who issue Penalty Charge Notices to vehicles parked illegally

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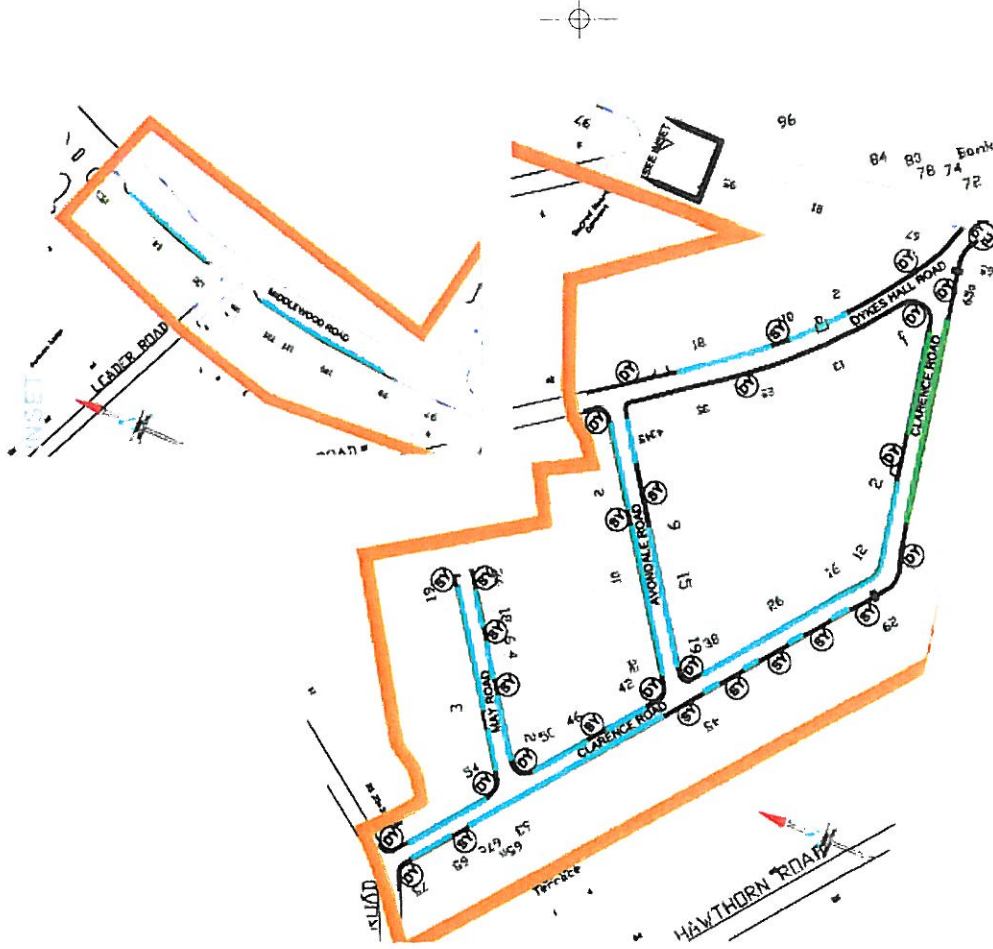
