

**Hillsborough Permit Parking Scheme 2a**

**How the scheme works**

- You will need to display a valid permit to park in Permit Holder parking bays during the hours of operation, four hours before kick-off until two hours after the final whistle
- Permit Holders can park for any length of time in these bays during the hours of operation
- You can buy Permits from the Council
- One hour Limited Waiting bays are available at no charge to non-permit holders
- Permits are specific to this scheme but not to individual streets
- The scheme cannot reserve specific spaces for individuals and does not guarantee there always being an available space
- Residents and Businesses will be able to have up to two permits per property

Disabled Blue Badge Holders will need a permit to park in a Permit Holder Only bay. You can park without time limit in Limited Waiting Bays and the normal rules apply elsewhere.

Yellow lines and parking bays are enforced by the Council's Civil Enforcement Officers who issue Penalty Charge Notices to vehicles parked illegally.

The temporary road closures and no waiting cones managed by Sheffield Wednesday's Stewards and the Police are unaffected by the scheme.

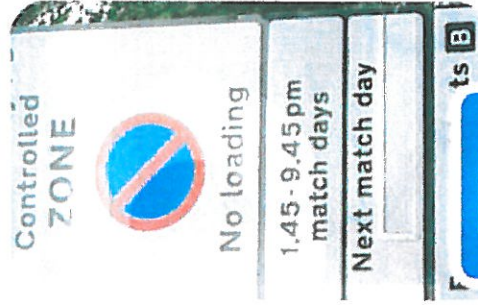

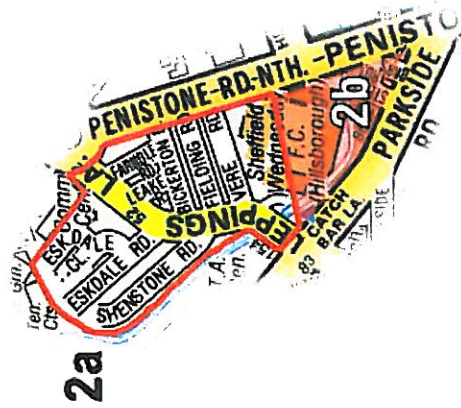

## Proposed Hillsborough Permit Match Day Parking Scheme 2a Vere Road Area

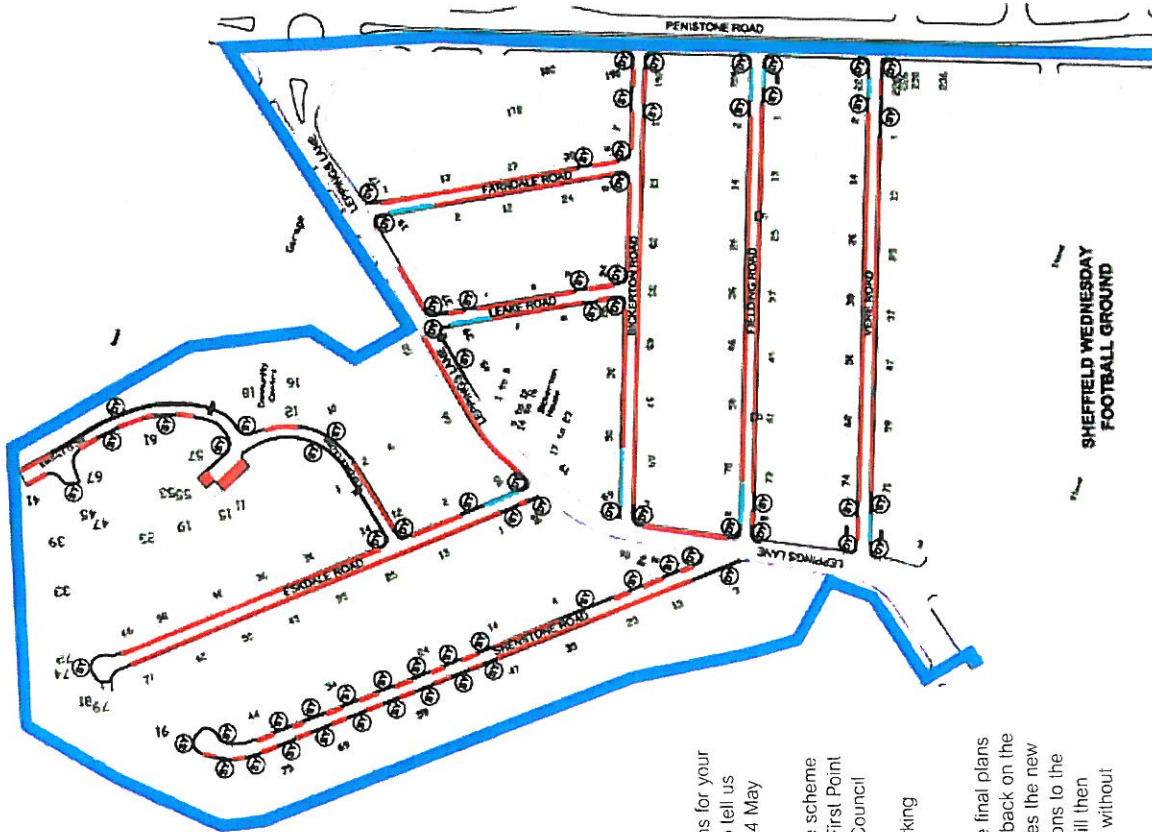


**KEY 2 (A) VERE ROAD AREA**

- DY Double Yellow Lines (No Parking At Any Time).
- SY Single Yellow Lines (No Parking on Match Days Only (4 hours before, during and 2 hours after a match).
- D Existing Disabled Bay.

The feedback from residents around the Sheffield Wednesday Football Ground has helped us decide which roads would be included in the scheme and when the scheme would operate. We have now put together detailed proposals which are shown in this leaflet.

### How did we choose the areas?

Your feedback showed that you have difficulty parking on match days but less difficulty at other times. We have combined that with comments from the Police, Sheffield Wednesday's Stewards and our own surveys to propose a manageable area for a scheme that only applies on match days. We are proposing a part-time scheme starting four hours before kick-off until two hours after the final whistle. The times will be advertised in advance on zone boundary signs for each match.

**PROPOSED CONTROLLED ZONE TO ADDRESS PARKING ISSUES ON MATCH DAYS.**

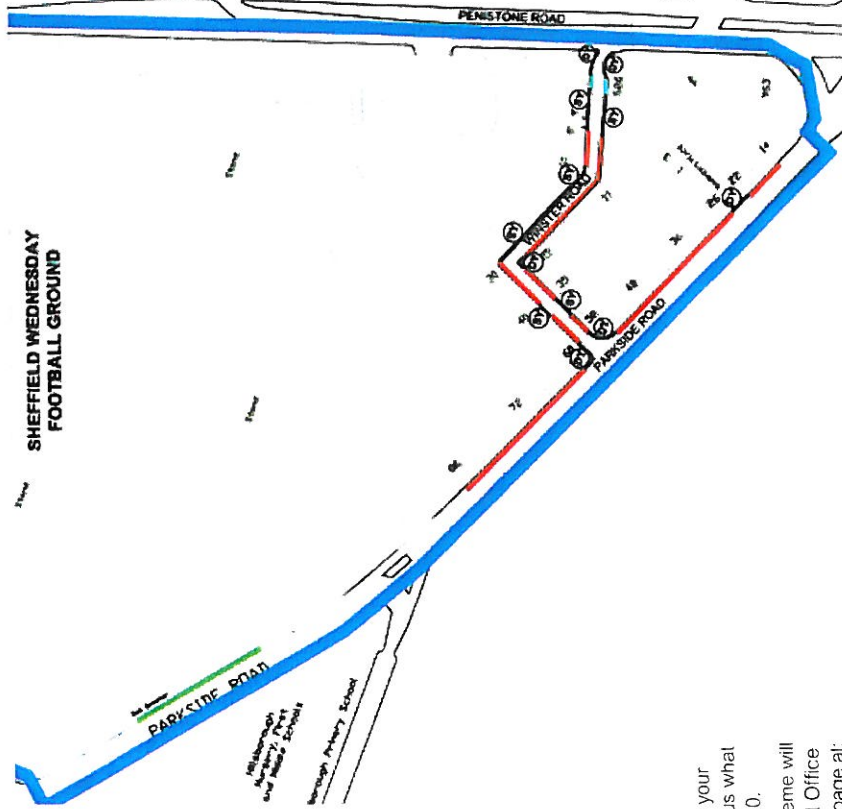
**PARKING RESTRICTIONS TO REBAR AS EXISTING EXCEPT WHERE INDICATED.**

- Parking limited to 2 hours. Mon - Sat, Sun - 8.30pm.
