AUDIT AND STANDARDS COMMITTEE 16 FEBRUARY

1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1 The report updates the committee of activity undertaken following the conclusion of the audit of the Open Housing Management System, in the discharge of functions falling to the Housing Policy Committee to oversee and scrutinise.
- 1.2 The report separately notes that an audit of the Housing Management System will be conducted as part of the 2023/24 audit plan. Where the outcome of an audit is a finding of *no assurance* or a *limited assurance with high organisational impact*, it will form the basis of a report to this committee.

2. Introduction and background

Audit Activity

2.1 On 16 June 2022 a report was presented to the Audit and Standards Committee which noted, in summary:

An internal audit review of the Open Housing Management System application was completed in January 2018 and reviewed in June 2018. There was a recommendation from the internal audit that:

the system is not currently up to date and considerable expense and effort will be required to enable this, it is recommended that an options review is undertaken to ascertain what the best method is to take the application forward.

The report will outline the work we have completed to meet the recommendations and an update on the replacement of the Housing Management System

2.2 The Committee resolved to agree the following recommendation:

to note this report and close the outstanding audit action as it is complete also note the progress to replace the Open Housing Management System and associated systems

- 2.3 The minutes (June 2022) recorded:
 - 7.9 A Member of the Committee asked if a further update could be provided to Members of the Committee around the implementation plan and key dates. The Director of Legal and Governance stated that the Housing Policy Committee may be better suited to oversee the implementation of the new system rather than the Audit & Standards Committee.
 - 7.10 RESOLVED: That (1) Members of the Audit and Standards Committee are recommended to note this report and close the outstanding audit action as it is complete also note the progress to replace the Open Housing Management System and associated systems; and (2) that regular updates on the implementation of the new system is passed to the Housing Policy Committee, and that this Committee is involved as and if necessary

Housing Policy Committee updates and oversight

2.4 Officers concerned with the delivery of the Housing Management System project have provided updates to Housing Policy Committee, reflecting its exclusive role as the supervisory committee with competence over its implementation. Those updates continue to be delivered in accordance with a programmed provision of knowledge updates.
