	The recommendation to reiterate the Council's recognition of Palestine as an independent state is likely to be welcomed by Muslim communities, whereas the decision not to join the Coalition is likely to be welcomed by some (if not all) Jewish groups in the city means that the decision not to join the Coalition is likely to be welcomed by some but not all Jewish groups in the city, or probably likely to be welcomed by all Jewish groups in the city.	
	I would appreciate a written response.	
Answer:	Thank you for your question, I'm happy to clarify this. Apologies for any imprecision in the wording - officers will correct this for future iterations of the equality impact assessment. The intention of this section of the equality impact assessment was to state that the decision not to join the coalition is likely to be welcomed by some but not all Jewish groups in the city.
