# 2. **DECISION TAKEN**

That, in accordance with the details contained in the report, approval be given to:-

- 2. The proposed extension to the King Edward VII Catchment area;
- 3. Proposed Admission Numbers; and
- 4. The statutory Primary and Secondary co-ordinated admission schemes.

#### 3. Reasons For Decision

The recommendation to approve the proposed admission arrangements for 2021/22 will ensure that the Authority carries out its statutory duty to consult and determine its admission arrangements for the 2021/22 academic year, including:-

- 2. The proposed extension to the King Edward VII Catchment area;
- 3. Proposed Admission Numbers; and
