- 3. Approves payments being made to third party providers if / where needed in accordance with the scheme;
- 4. Approves the cohort for FSM being replicated for all families in this cohort and approves food vouchers being provided to these families in the school holidays;
- 5. Approves the additional cohorts of CIN, MAST and Early Years and agrees to providing the same vouchers to them;
- Delegates authority to the Executive Director of People Services in consultation with the appropriate Cabinet Member nominated by the Leader to approve the final scheme eligibility criteria; and
- 7. Delegates authority to the Executive Director of People Services, in

consultation with the Director of Finance and Commercial Services and the Director of Legal and Governance to take any other decisions necessary in order to meet the aims, objectives and outcomes of this report which are not already covered by existing delegations in the Leaders Scheme of Delegation.
