BK1 and MT1).

- 8.2 RESOLVED: That upon consideration of the cases, and with due regard to the additional information now submitted, the Committee considers that (a) there has been a material change in the families' circumstances in two cases and therefore authorises the Executive Director to process new applications in these cases (Case Nos. 1 and 4); (b) there has not been a material change in the families' circumstances in Case Nos. 2 and 5 and therefore authority be not given for new applications to be processed in these cases; and (c) one case be deferred and the Executive Director be requested to obtain further information from the family (Case No.3).
