98/23	Application for the renewal of a Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence	(a) Grant a licence for 3 years, as applied for, on the grounds that the Sub-Committee considers the applicant to be a fit and proper person to hold a licence, (b) that a warning be issued on the license for the term of 3 years, and (c) that the applicant be required to undertake the BTEC qualification before the expiry of his next licence.
83/23	Application to be exempted from certain conditions of a Private Hire Vehicle Licence	Due to the bespoke nature of the business, the applicant be exempted from those conditions requiring door signage to be displayed whilst carrying out executive bookings.
