## Notice under Section 5: Notice of Decisions to be taken in Private

Pursuant to Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, **I hereby give notice** of:-

The intention of the Cabinet to take, partly in private session, a key decision on **the Business Services Sourcing Strategy** at its meeting on 12 November 2014
