Appendix G of the Executive Director, Place's report to Cabinet entitled 'University of Sheffield Campus – Sheffield City Region Investment Fund' is presented as an exempt item because it contains exempt information under paragraph 5 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended) ("Information in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings").

In considering this exemption the report author has decided that in all the circumstances of the case the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information, because of the nature of the information provided, and the importance of maintaining the principle of lawyer / client confidentiality to ensure that Cabinet is able to receive appropriate legal advice in all cases.
