03-Oct-2018 email	<p>Dear Sir</p> <p>My name is *****, and I'm a resident of *** Baslow Road, Totley, Sheffield.</p> <p>I'm writing in response to your letter Ref TR/T/TRO/03 dated 26th September.</p> <p>I'm disappointed to hear that your are proposing to downgrade the parking restriction from double red to double yellow to the east of the pedestrian crossing.</p> <p>Please could you consider keeping the double red for a short distance either side of the access road that runs between 259 and 261 Baslow Road? Since the newly enlarged school opened in September we are regularly experiencing cars parked within a few feet of the entrance to this access road. It makes both entry into and exit from this road dangerous - especially exit, as visibility down Baslow Road can be severely limited as a result of this parking. I sincerely believe that the possibility of a serious accident has been greatly increased by this parking, and that only a no-stopping regulation would be sufficiently strong to deter people from leaving their cars here during school-run journeys.</p> <p>Thank you for your attention.</p> <p>Regards, *****</p>
