Decision to be removed from Call-in process:-

The decision to

- Approve the revised opening hours of 9.30am to 5.30pm (1st April to 30th September) and 9.30am to 3.30pm (1st October to 31st March) from 1st April 2021 for Sheffield's Household Waste Recycling Centres as outlined in this report.
- Approve the Council issuing a notice of change to Veolia to reflect the change of opening hours.

Reasons for Urgency

The Household Waste Recycling Sites change to their summer opening hours on 1st April. If this decision cannot be implemented such that the change to the opening hours comes into effect at the same time as the move to the summer opening hours it will cause disruption for Veolia, who operate the sites, and confusion for members of the public. It is not in anybody's interests that the opening hours of the sites change twice within the space of a few days. Veolia also need time to implement the change, including making changes to employee terms and conditions.
