

Hearing to consider a notice of objection to a Temporary Event Notice

Horse and Jockey, 248-250 Wadsley Lane, Sheffield, S6 4EF

1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider an objection submitted by the Environmental Protection Service in relation to a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) for the premises known as Horse and Jockey, 248-250 Wadsley Lane, Sheffield, S6 4EF.

2.0 THE TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE

- 2.1 The applicant is Hannah Mary Beddow, who is the Designated Premises Supervisor for the premises.
- 2.2 The Temporary Event Notice was received on the 5th August 2022 and is attached to this report at Appendix 'A.
- 2.3 The event is described as follows:
 - "Oktoberfest" 6pm 9pm majority of music will be background music played through speakers, with a playlist and a live set from a professional umpah band playing with no PA, however they will play with a trombone & horns for a 45 minute set, 7-7.45pm.
- 2.4 The details of the licensable activities applied for are:
 - Saturday 17th September 2022 18:00 to 21:00
 - The provision of regulated entertainment
- 2.5 The Notice was served to the relevant Responsible Authorities on the 5th August 2022.

3.0 REASONS FOR REFERRAL

- 3.1 A notice of objection was received from Environmental Protection on the 5th August 2022. Details of the objection and further information is attached at Appendix 'B'.
- 3.2 The applicant and the objector have been invited to attend the hearing. Copies of the front page of the notices are attached to this report labelled Appendix 'C'.

4.0 POLICIES AND DOCUMENTS TO CONSIDER

4.1 Sheffield City Council Licensing Policy

5.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

5.1 There are no specific financial implications arising from this application. However, additional costs may be incurred should the matter go to appeal. In such an eventuality it may not be possible to recover all these costs. The impact of these additional costs (if any) will be kept under review and may be subject of a further report during the year.

6.0 THE LEGAL POSITION

- 6.1 A Chief Police Officer or Environmental Health of the Local Authority may object to a Temporary Event Notice within 3 working days of receiving the Notice.
- 6.2 Where such an objection is received, the relevant licensing authority must
 - (a) hold a hearing to consider the objection notice, unless the premises user, the relevant person who gave the objection notice and the authority agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and
 - (b) having regard to the objection notice, give the premises user a counter notice under this section if it considers it necessary for the promotion of the relevant licensing objective to do so.

7.0 HEARING REGULATIONS

- 7.1 Regulations governing hearings under the Licensing Act 2003 have been made by the Secretary of State.
- 7.2 The Licensing Authority has provided all parties with the information required in the Regulations to the 2003 Act as set out at Appendix 'C'.
- 7.3 Attached at Appendix 'C' is the following:
 - a) a copy of the Notice of Hearing;
 - b) the rights of a party provided in Regulations 15 and 16;
 - c) the consequences if a party does not attend or is not represented at the hearing
 - d) the procedure to be followed at the hearing.

8.0 APPEALS

8.1 The Licensing Act 2003 section 181 and Schedule 5 makes provision for appeals to be made by the premises user and the chief officer of Police against decisions of the Licensing Authority, to the Magistrates' Court.

9.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

9.1 That members carefully consider the representations made and take such steps, as the Committee consider necessary for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.

10.0 OPTIONS OPEN TO THE COMMITTEE

- 10.1 To acknowledge the Temporary Event Notice, allowing the event to go ahead on the proposed date as per the notice submitted.
- 10.2 To give the premises user a counter notice if it considers it necessary for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives.

This emailed representation is made in accordance with the agreement with the Licensing Authority on the 18th October 2006 to accept representations by email.

Dear Ms Hannah Beddow,

In respect of the attached Temporary Event Notice (TEN) for 17/09/2022, please take this as formal advice of my objection to this TEN. The objection is made in my capacity of Environmental Protection Officer for Sheffield City Council, acting as Responsible Authority for the Prevention of Public Nuisance. The objection is made on the basis of likely public nuisance arising from the noise associated with this outside event.

The Premises Licence Holder, True North Brew Co, previously sought my views on the Oktoberfest event prior to this TEN being received, and I communicated the likelihood of the this objection at that time. The reasons are as set out in the attached email response to Marc Craddock on this topic, dated 19/07/2022. For ease of reference, in that email I advised:

"In my view the Oktoberfest event would be ill-advised. As we've established, the premises is extremely noise-sensitive. The relaxations the NMP permits for pre-notified events were intended to allow due consideration of a small number of appropriately low key events, both in terms of the entertainment provision and the character of the events in general. Oktoberfest is, by definition and tradition, a bawdy affair. Whilst acoustic, the entertainment described is loud, intrusive and cannot be readily reduced in volume. The noise from patrons partaking in this type of event would reasonably be anticipated to be higher than for an average event. Entertainers of the type referenced encourage a degree of audience participation, as is demonstrated by the description that they walk around the audience and take requests.

I would be minded to object, and to allow the Licensing Subcommittee to make a decision in respect of such a proposal."

I maintain this position now, on behalf of SCC EPS Commercial Team, and therefore object to this TEN outright.

Right of attendance, assistance and representation

15. Subject to regulations 14(2) and 25, a party may attend the hearing and may be assisted or represented by any person whether or not that person is legally qualified.

Representations and supporting information

- 16. At the hearing a party shall be entitled to
 - (a) in response to a point upon which the authority has given notice to a party that it will want clarification under regulation 7(1)(d), give further information in support of their application, representations or notice (as applicable),
 - (b) if given permission by the authority, question any other party; and
 - (c) address the authority

Failure of parties to attend the hearing

- 20. (1) If a party has informed the authority that he does not intend to attend or be represented at a hearing, the hearing may proceed in his absence.
 - (2) If a party who has not so indicated fails to attend or be represented at a hearing the authority may:—
 - (a) where it considers it to be necessary in the public interest, adjourn the hearing to a specified date, or
 - (b) hold the hearing in the party's absence.
 - (3) Where the authority holds the hearing in the absence of a party, the authority shall consider at the hearing the application, representations or notice made by that party.
 - (4) Where the authority adjourns the hearing to a specified date it must forthwith notify the parties of the date, time and place to which the hearing has been adjourned.

Procedure at hearing

- 21. Subject to the provisions of the Regulations, the authority shall determine the procedure to be followed at the hearing.
- 22. At the beginning of the hearing, the authority shall explain to the parties the procedure which it proposes to follow at the hearing and shall consider any request made by a party under regulation 8(2) for permission for another person to appear at the hearing, such permission shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 23. A hearing shall take the form of a discussion led by the authority and cross-examination shall not be permitted unless the authority considers that cross-examination is required for it to consider the representations, application or notice as the case may require.
- 24. The authority must allow the parties an equal maximum period of time in which to exercise their rights provided for at regulation 16.
- 25. The authority may require any person attending the hearing who in their opinion is behaving in a disruptive manner to leave the hearing and may
 - (a) refuse to permit that person to return, or
 - (b) permit him to return only on such conditions as the authority may specify, but such a person may, before the end of the hearing, submit to the authority in writing any information which they would have been entitled to give orally had they not been required to leave.

Regulation 8

- (1) A party shall give to the authority within the period of time provided for in the following provisions of this regulation a notice stating
 - (a) whether he intends to attend or be represented at the hearing;
 - (b) whether he considers a hearing to be unnecessary
- (2) In a case where a party wishes any other person (other than the person he intends to represent him at the hearing) to appear at the hearing, the notice referred to in paragraph (1) shall contain a request for permission for such other person to appear at the hearing accompanied by details of the name of that person and a brief description of the point or points on which that person may be able to assist the authority in relation to the application, representations or notice of the party making the request.
- (3) In the case of a hearing under
 - (a) section 48(3)(a) (cancellation of interim authority notice following police objection), or
 - (b) section 105(2)(a) (counter notice following police objection to temporary event notice),

the party shall give the notice no later than one working day before the day or the first day on which the hearing is to be held.

- (4) In the case of a hearing under -
 - (a) section 167(5)(a) (review of premises licence following closure order),
 - (b) paragraph 4(3)(a) of Schedule 8 (determination of application for conversion of existing licence), paragraph 16(3)(a) of Schedule 8 (determination of application for conversion of existing club certificate)
 - (c) paragraph 26(3)(a) of Schedule 8 (determination of application by holder of justices' licence for grant of personal licence),

the party shall give the notice no later than two working days before the day or the first day on which the hearing is to be held.

(5) In any other case, the party shall give the notice no later than five working days before the day or the first day on which the hearing is to be held.

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
