

### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider an application for the grant of a premises licence made under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.

### 2.0 THE APPLICATION

- 2.1 The applicant is Mrs Gamze Emin.
- 2.2 The application was received by the Licensing Service on 13<sup>th</sup> September 2022 and is attached at Appendix 'A' of this report.
- 2.3 The application form submitted refers to the supply of alcohol *on the premises*, however this was an error, and the application is for supply of alcohol *off the premises*.
- 2.4 It is noted that there have been no comments or agreed conditions submitted by any of the Responsible Authorities in regard to this Premises Licence Application.

### 3.0 REASONS FOR REFERRAL

- 3.1 Unresolved representations concerning the application have been received from the following and are attached at Appendix 'B':

Dear Sirs,

I would like to register my objection to the application for the supply of on sale alcohol between the hours of 8:00 to 23:00 Monday to Saturday & 08:00 to 23:00 Sundays and bank holidays at 715-717 Abbeydale Road, Sheffield, S7 2BE made by Mrs Gamze Emin.

I object on the basis of the following:

- The location is extremely close to quiet residential housing.
- A business whose principle hours are late night is not compatible with this location. Increased numbers of people, vehicles, noise and alcohol up to 11:00 at night is not appropriate for a dense residential area and it significantly raises the risk of criminal and disorderly behaviour including the possibility of damage to residents property/cars both from the residents of the 10 bed dwelling houses due to be located on the top two floors of the new development (most likely rowdy students) and other customers of the shop.
- Parking space is at a premium on Langdale Road, Coniston Road & Edgedale Road, which have all been adversely affected by the Sheaf Valley Cycleway road closures in recent months. The premises include absolutely no parking space for customers meaning that customers who travel by car to the shop are likely to exacerbate known parking problems on these adjacent side roads. Furthermore, licensing the premises is likely to increase the potential for drink-driving.
- The licensing of a premises in this location is wholly unnecessary given the number of other supermarkets/ outlets selling alcohol located further down Abbeydale Road in either direction which are not located in such close proximity to a densely packed residential area. Licensing will also mean that G Mila Supermarket is likely to impinge upon the business of community minded retailers in the near vicinity, who are more valuable to this area than a late night supermarket selling alcohol.
- Lastly, I feel it is wholly irresponsible & inappropriate to license a premises for the sale of alcohol so close to the alcohol rehab centre Project 6 (formerly named Sheffield Alcohol Support Service) located at 646 Abbeydale Road and even on this basis alone the application should be refused outright.

Further to my above objection above, I have delivered a petition for the refusal of the alcohol license for this premises to the Town Hall earlier today which has been signed by some 178 local residents at last count. Therefore, I ask that this is also fully taken into account when considering this application as it clearly constitutes a substantial amount of local objection to the approval of the liquor license.

To whom it may concern,

We would like to register our objection to the application for the supply of on sale alcohol between the hours of 8:00 to 23:00 Monday to Saturday & 08:00 to 23:00 Sundays and bank holidays at 715-717 Abbeydale Road, Sheffield, S7 2BE made by Mrs Gamze Emin.

We object on the basis of the following:

- The location is extremely close to quiet residential housing. The proposed shop directly backs onto (via a partition wall) our garden (74 Coniston Road) and will interfere with the privacy and quiet enjoyment of our garden, which is crucial for our mental health and wellbeing.
- The late night opening of this shop is out of place with the local area, where most businesses are shut at 5pm-9pm and are closed on Sundays and Bank Holidays. Increased numbers of people, vehicles, noise and alcohol up to 11:00 at night is not appropriate for a dense residential area and it significantly raises the risk of criminal and disorderly behaviour including the possibility of damage to residents property/cars both from the residents of the 10 bed dwelling houses due to be located on the top two floors of the new development and other customers of the shop who then stay and consume alcohol in the local vicinity.
- Parking space is limited on Langdale Road, Coniston Road & Edgedale Road, which have all been adversely affected by the Sheaf Valley Cycleway road closures and extensive double yellow lines being added on Little London road in recent months. The premises provide no parking space for customers. This means that customers who travel by car to the shop are likely to exacerbate known parking problems on these adjacent side roads. Furthermore, licensing the premises is likely to increase the potential for drink-driving.
- The licensing of a premises in this location is unnecessary given the number of other supermarkets/outlets selling alcohol located further down Abbeydale Road in either direction (Tescos Superstore Abbeydale road and Ranet Retail, 621-627 Abbeydale Road) which are not located in such close proximity to a densely packed residential area. Licensing will also mean that G Mila Supermarket is likely to negatively impact on the business of community-minded retailers (e.g. A M News, Sharps of Sheffield fruit and vegetables, and Northtown kitchen) in the near vicinity. These businesses are much more valuable in this area than a late night supermarket selling alcohol.



### Right of attendance, assistance and representation

15. Subject to regulations 14(2) and 25, a party may attend the hearing and may be assisted or represented by any person whether or not that person is legally qualified.

### Representations and supporting information

- 16. At the hearing a party shall be entitled to
  - (a) in response to a point upon which the authority has given notice to a party that it will want clarification under regulation 7(1)(d), give further information in support of their application, representations or notice (as applicable),
  - (b) if given permission by the authority, question any other party; and

### Failure of parties to attend the hearing
