70/23	Review of a Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver's Licence	The licence holder be issued with a written warning as to his future conduct, in the light of the incident now reported, to remain live for the term of his current licence.
71/23	Application for a Hackney Carriage Vehicle Licence	Grant a licence for 12 months, as requested.
