The story so far...

- Submitted Prospectus to government in September 2021.
- Government requested bus prioritisation theme.
- Government confirmed £570m funding in July 2022
- The A61 Chesterfield Road scheme was already a high priority for SCC
- £10m allocated to the A61 Chesterfield Road project.
- Business cases are objective led, so generated a very long list of delivery options.

Desired outcomes

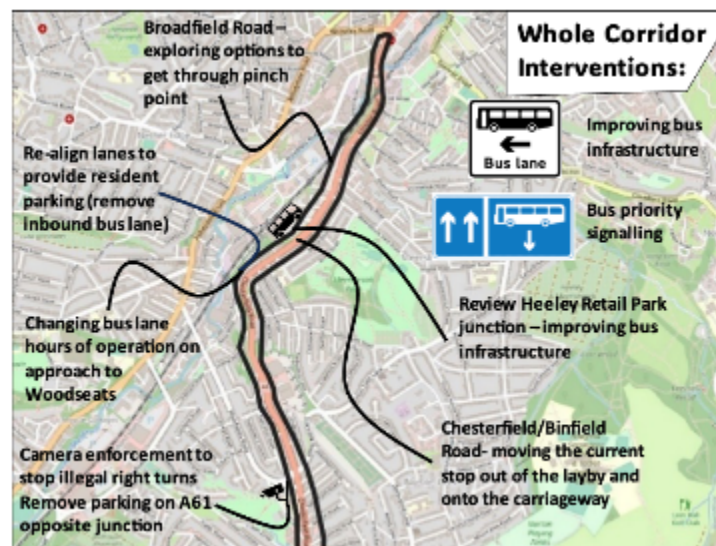
- Make A61 Chesterfield Road more efficient with better bus options.
