Executive Summary:

This report marks the completion of the first stage of the Health Scrutiny Sub Committee's (HSSC) project on Dentistry Services in Sheffield, which comprises a Have Your Say survey and a follow up workshop.

The aim was to respond to concerns raised about the accessibility of Dentistry Services in Sheffield and to the wider work being carried out by the South Yorkshire Integrated Care Board (SY ICB) on the development of Dentistry across the whole of South Yorkshire. Also to identify any recommendations about improvements to services and to feed this back to SY ICB.
